entities holding an ownership interest in the named defendants can be ascertained, most of
the relevant owners, trustees, and partners have not been disclosed, leaving both plaintiffs
and the Court unable to verify their citizenship. Because "it is to be presumed that a cause
of action lies outside the limited jurisdiction of the federal courts and the burden of
establishing the contrary rests upon the party asserting jurisdiction," the Court "resolves
all ambiguity in favor of remand to state court." <u>Hunter v. Philip Morris USA</u>, 582 F.3d
1039, 1042 (9th Cir. 2009) (internal quotation marks and alterations omitted).

The Clerk of Court is therefore directed to REMAND this matter to King County Superior Court. Defendants' request for a two week extension of time in which to show cause (Dkt. # 13) is DENIED as moot.
