
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

17 On January 25, 2017, the court dismissed *pro se* Plaintiff Nina French's complaint
18 without prejudice and granted her 14 days to amend that complaint. (1/25/17 Order (Dkt.
19 # 32).) The court found that Ms. French had not met her burden of establishing the
20 court's subject matter jurisdiction (*id.* at 7) and had not made sufficient factual
21 allegations to state a claim under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act, the Americans with
22 Disabilities Act, or Washington law (*id.* at 8). Despite these deficiencies and in light of
Ms. French's *pro se* status, the court granted Ms. French 14 days to amend the complaint.

1 (*Id.* at 8-10.) The court cautioned Ms. French that her failure to timely amend the
2 complaint or remedy the deficiencies identified in the court's order would result in
3 dismissal without leave to amend. (*Id.* at 9.)

4 Ms. French's deadline to file an amended complaint passed on February 8, 2017,
5 and she has filed nothing further in this matter. (*See Dkt.*) Accordingly, the court
6 DISMISSES this case WITH PREJUDICE.
