## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 25, 2017, the court dismissed *pro se* Plaintiff Nina French's complaint but prejudice and granted her 14 days to amend that complaint. (1/25/17 Order (Dkt. 14)) The court found that Ms. French had not met her burden of establishing the subject matter jurisdiction (*id.* at 7) and had not made sufficient factual allegations to state a claim under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act, the Americans with Disabilities Act, or Washington law (*id.* at 8). Despite these deficiencies and in light of French's *pro se* status, the court granted Ms. French 14 days to amend the complaint.

1 (Id. at 8-10.) The court cautioned Ms. French that her failure to timely amend the  
2 complaint or remedy the deficiencies identified in the court's order would result in  
3 dismissal without leave to amend. (Id. at 9.)

4 Ms. French's deadline to file an amended complaint passed on February 8, 2017,  
5 and she has filed nothing further in this matter. (See Dkt.) Accordingly, the court  
6 DISMISSES this case WITH PREJUDICE.
