On 2 March 8, 2018, the court ordered the parties to submit proposals recommending how the 3 court should proceed in light of the Federal Circuit's decision. (3/8/18 Order (Dkt. # 50) 4 at 2.) 5 In response, the parties propose that the court continue the stay until there is a 6 decision on RDMI's petition for a writ of *certiorari* to the United States Supreme Court. 7 (Pl. Resp. (Dkt. # 51) at 2; Def. Resp. (Dkt. # 52) at 2.) Given the parties' agreement and 8 the pending petition, the court ORDERS that this case remain stayed until the court 9 directs otherwise. The court further ORDERS RDMI to file a status report no later than 10 ninety (90) days from the entry of this order and to file a status report every ninety (90) 11 days until the court lifts the stay. The status report shall inform the court of the status of 12 the petition for a writ of *certiorari* and/or further proceedings before the Supreme Court, 13 the expected timeline for resolution, and any other developments affecting the resolution 14 of this matter.
