17 The court has received Plaintiffs N.E., C.E., and P.E.'s (collectively, "Plaintiffs")
18 response (Resp. to OSC (Dkt. # 25)) to the court's March 9, 2017, order to show cause
19 why this case should not be dismissed as moot (OSC (Dkt. # 24)). Based on Plaintiffs'

21 ORDERS the parties to file a joint status report ("JSR") no later than April 30, 2017, that

2 parties shall limit their JSR to no more than five (5) pages, and Plaintiffs are responsible
3 for filing the JSR.
