

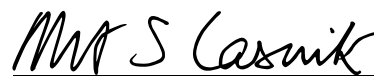


1 The Court thereafter ordered that Petitioner's original petition and his motion to stay and  
2 abey be served on Respondent, and that Respondent file a response only to Petitioner's motion to  
3 stay and abey. (Dkt. # 18.) Respondent indicated in his response to Petitioner's motion that he  
4 did not oppose the requested stay and, on July 1, 2016, the Court issued an Order granting the  
5 motion and staying this action pending completion of Petitioner's state court collateral  
6 proceedings. (Dkt. ## 22, 23.) Petitioner was subsequently directed to file a report every 180  
7 days advising the Court of the status of his state court proceedings. (Dkt. # 25.)

8 On April 30, 2019, the Court received from Petitioner a status report and motion to  
9 dismiss his federal habeas petition. (Dkt. # 29.) Petitioner's counsel explains therein that  
10 Petitioner's conviction was vacated by the King County Superior Court on September 20, 2018  
11 and a new trial date was set. (*Id.*) However, Petitioner has since been deported and is therefore  
12 unavailable to be brought to court for trial. (*Id.*) Counsel further explains that the Washington  
13 Court of Appeals has issued a mandate terminating its involvement in the case and it thus  
14 appears that Petitioner's habeas petition is moot. (*Id.*)

15 Though Petitioner's federal habeas petition was served on Respondent, Respondent has  
16 never filed an answer or other responsive pleading. It is therefore appropriate to treat Petitioner's  
17 motion as a request for voluntary dismissal and to terminate this action without seeking a  
18 response from Respondent. Accordingly, Petitioner's motion to dismiss (dkt. # 29) is  
19 GRANTED and this federal habeas action is DISMISSED without prejudice.
