ORDER GRANTING EAJA  
ATTORNEY FEES

20 This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff Christin Kelly's unopposed motion for  
21 attorney fees (Dkt. No. 22). Plaintiff's motion is GRANTED. Plaintiff is hereby AWARDED  
22 attorney fees in the amount of \$5,048.38 and expenses in the amount of \$20.22 pursuant to the  
23 Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d). If the U.S. Department of the  
24 Treasury determines that Plaintiff's EAJA fees, expenses, and costs are not subject to any offset  
25 allowed under the Department of the Treasury's Offset Program, as discussed in *Astrue v. Ratliff*,  
26 560 U.S. 586 (2010), payment of this award shall be made to Plaintiff's attorney, Robert  
Friedman. Whether payable to Plaintiff, or to Robert Friedman, the check shall be mailed to
