RECOMMENDATION



16 The Court, having reviewed the Report and Recommendation of Judge J. Richard
17 Creatura, United States Magistrate Judge, and the relevant record, does hereby find and ORDER:

- 18
19 (1) The Court adopts the Report and Recommendation.¹
20 (2) The matter is **REVERSED** and **REMANDED** pursuant to sentence four of 42
21 U.S.C. § 405(g) to the Commissioner for further consideration.

24 ¹ Defendant does not object to the bulk of the Report and Recommendation, but asks the Court
25 not to adopt certain statements in Part 2 of the Discussion. The challenged statements appear in the
26 context of the Report and Recommendation's conclusion that substantial evidence does not support the
27 ALJ's finding that plaintiff has the residual functional capacity to perform medium work. Because this
conclusion is sufficiently justified by Part 1 of the Discussion (finding that the ALJ insufficiently
considered available medical evidence), the Court need not address the statements identified by
defendant.

- 1 (3) **JUDGMENT** is for plaintiff and the case should be closed.
2 (4) The Clerk is directed to send copies of this Order to counsel of record.
