ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S
MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE AND
GRANTING STIPULATION

19 This matter comes before the Court on Defendant United States of America's Motion
20 for a Continuance, Dkt. #20, and the Agreed Stipulation and Order Regarding Trial, Dkt. #21.
21 The Court has reviewed the briefing of the parties and finds that good cause has not been
22 established by the Government for a 60-day extension of the trial date and related deadlines.
23 The Government has submitted no real evidence to support a good cause finding, arguing
24 without citation that "[s]ettlement by the United States involves input and scrutiny at several
25 levels, and more time is needed for that process to proceed." Dkt. #20 at 2.
