MINUTE ORDER

12 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable  
13 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

14 (1) Defendant Safeway, Inc.'s ("Safeway") motion for summary judgment,  
15 docket no. 39, is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part. With regard to plaintiff's  
16 claims for disability discrimination and retaliation, Safeway's motion is DENIED  
17 because disputes of material fact preclude summary judgment. As to plaintiff's claims  
18 for disability-based hostile work environment in violation of the ADA and the WLAD,  
19 and plaintiff's claim for negligent infliction of emotional distress, Safeway's motion is  
20 GRANTED and the claims are DISMISSED with prejudice. The Court will enter an  
21 Order explaining its decision in the near future.
