MINUTE ORDER

11 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable  
12 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

13 (1) Plaintiff's motion, docket no. 62, concerning the noting date of defendants  
14 City of Seattle's and Officer Eugene Schubeck's motion for summary judgment is  
15 DENIED in part and GRANT in part as follows. To the extent plaintiff contends that  
16 defendants' motion for summary judgment was untimely filed or improperly noted for the  
17 fourth Friday after it was filed, plaintiff's motion is DENIED. To the extent plaintiff asks  
18 for an extension of time to respond to defendants' motion for summary judgment because  
19 of plaintiff's counsel's family health issues, plaintiff's motion is GRANTED, and any
