20	Extension of Time to File Joint Notice of Appeal. Dkt. #42. Despite filing its motion for		
21	extension of time, LHF filed a Notice of Civil Appeal on the same day. See Dkt. #43. Pursuant		
22	to Rule 4(a)(1)(A) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, in a civil case a notice of		
23	appeal "must be filed with the district clerk within 30 days after entry of the judgment or order		

extension of time, LHF filed a Notice of Civil Appeal on the same day. *See* Dkt. #43. Pursuant to Rule 4(a)(1)(A) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, in a civil case a notice of appeal "must be filed with the district clerk within 30 days after entry of the judgment or order appealed from." Here, the Court entered the Order LHF seeks to appeal on February 15, 2017. *See* Dkts. #39 and #40. Consequently, LHF had until March 17, 2017, to file its Notice of Appeal. Because LHF timely filed its appeal in the Ninth Circuit, the Court STRIKES LHF's Motion for Extension of Time to File Joint Notice of Appeal as MOOT.
