

1 intends at that time to issue a ruling on Defendant's motion for summary 2 judgment requesting dismissal of the claims of the Hanousek plaintiffs. 3 Discovery is suspended until the ruling on class certification. 4 No further dispositive motions are to be filed until after the ruling on class 5 certification and the other motions listed *supra*. 6 Plaintiffs' motion to compel (Dkt. No. 146) is stricken along with Defendant's 7 motions for extension of discovery motion deadline (Dkt. No. 176) and for 8 protective order (Dkt. No. 150). Both Dkt. No. 146 and Dkt. No. 150 may be re-9 noted if necessary, consistent with the Court's order at Dkt. No. 181. 10 Upon the resumption of discovery following the rulings listed *supra*, Plaintiffs 11 will be permitted a single 30(b)(6) deposition for (1) topics not previously 12 covered and (2) topics not eliminated by agreement of the parties. 13 14 The clerk is ordered to provide copies of this order to all counsel. 15 Dated: December 14, 2017. 16 Maisluf Helens 17 Marsha J.
