ORDER STAYING CASE

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14 On June 22, 2017, Plaintiff informed the Court that it had received notice of Chapter 7  
15 bankruptcy proceedings involving Defendant.<sup>1</sup> Dkt. #46. Thus, it appears that this matter is now

24 the Court’s motion calendar. Once the stay is lifted and this matter proceeds, the
