MINUTE ORDER REGARDING
MOTIONS IN LIMINE

15 The following minute order is made by the direction of the court, the Honorable Marsha
16 J. Pechman, United States District Judge: The Court has reviewed the parties Motions in Limine,
17 which were originally filed on November 9 and 15, 2017. (Dkt. Nos. 30, 33.) The Court notes
18 that:

19 (1) Plaintiff filed his Motions in Limine without meeting and conferring as required by

20 Local Rule 7(j); and

21 (2) On December 15, 2017, the Honorable Robert S. Lasnik granted Defendants' Motion

22 for Partial Summary Judgment, dismissing a number of claims from the lawsuit.
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1 Because it appears that several of the Motions in Limine are no longer contested and/or
2 relevant to the remaining claims, the Court STRIKES the previously-filed Motions in Limine and
3 Supplemental Motions in Limine and all related pleadings (Dkt. Nos. 30, 31, 33, 35, 37, 41, 42)
4 and ORDERS the parties to file Amended Motions in Limine no later than June 11, 2018. The
5 parties are directed to meet and confer prior to filing and to raise only those issues that are
6 relevant to the remaining claims to be presented at trial.
