15	The following minute order is made by the direction of the court, the Honorable Marsha	
16	J. Pechman, United States District Judge: The Court has reviewed the parties Motions in Limine,	
17	which were originally filed on November 9 and 15, 2017. (Dkt. Nos. 30, 33.) The Court notes	
18	that:	
19	(1) Plaintiff filed his Motions in Limine without meeting and conferring as required by	
20	Local Rule 7(j); and	
21	(2) On December 15, 2017, the Honorable Robert S. Lasnik granted Defendants' Motion	
22	for Partial Summary Judgment, dismissing a number of claims from the lawsuit.	
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Because it appears that several of the Motions in Limine are no longer contested and/or relevant to the remaining claims, the Court STRIKES the previously-filed Motions in Limine and Supplemental Motions in Limine and all related pleadings (Dkt. Nos. 30, 31, 33, 35, 37, 41, 42) and ORDERS the parties to file Amended Motions in Limine no later than June 11, 2018. The parties are directed to meet and confer prior to filing and to raise only those issues that are relevant to the remaining claims to be presented at trial.
