16 Coughenour, United States District Judge:

17 This matter comes before the Court on the parties' stipulation and proposed order for  
18 dismissal (Dkt. No. 12). Under Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), a case may be dismissed without a  
19 court order if there is a "stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared." All  
20 parties who have appeared stipulate that all claims shall be dismissed with prejudice. Thus, under  
21 Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A), this stipulation is self-executing. This action is DISMISSED with
