MINUTE ORDER

12 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable  
13 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

14 (1) The parties' stipulated motion to extend discovery deadlines, docket no. 19,  
15 is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part. As indicated in the Minute Order Setting  
16 Trial Date and Related Dates, docket no. 13, failure to complete discovery within the  
17 time allowed is not recognized as good cause for altering the case schedule. Parties may  
18 agree to pursue settlement discussions and delay conducting discovery, but they should  
19 not expect the Court to continue discovery deadlines solely for that reason. The parties  
20 have proposed to extend the deadline for completing discovery until after dispositive  
21 motions must be filed. Such request is denied. Instead, the Court EXTENDS the  
22 deadline for completing discovery to August 4, 2017. Any motions related to discovery  
23 shall be filed by June 29, 2017. All other dates and deadlines set forth in the Minute  
Order Setting Trial Date and Related Dates, docket no. 13, shall remain in full force and  
effect.

(2) The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Minute Order to all counsel of  
record.
