ORDER

16 On September 28, 2017, Plaintiff A.T. filed a motion to compel a response to  
17 Interrogatory No. 2 from Defendant Everett School District (“the District”). (MTC (Dkt.  
18 # 41).) The court reprimands A.T. and her counsel for filing the motion in contravention  
19 of the court’s scheduling order, which requires a party to request a conference with the  
20 court before moving for an order related to discovery. (Sched. Order (Dkt. # 20) at 2.)  
21 The court expects the parties and their counsel to comply with all court orders and  
22 applicable rules and will consider appropriate sanctions for future violations.

1 Nevertheless, given that the deadline for filing discovery motions is September 29, 2017,  
2 and the discovery cutoff is October 30, 2017, the court will consider A.T.'s motion. (*See*  
3 *id.* at 1.) Accordingly, the court DIRECTS the District to respond to the motion subject  
4 to the Local Rules for the Western District of Washington. *See* Local Rules W.D. Wash.  
5 LCR 7(b)(2); *id.* LCR 7(d). A.T. may, but is not required to, file a reply in support of her  
6 motion no later than the noting date. *See id.* LCR 7(b)(3); *id.* LCR 7(d).
