This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiffs' second motion for class certification (Dkt. No. 220). The Court denied Plaintiffs' first motion for class certification without prejudice because this matter was subject to a stay. (*See* Dkt. No. 194.) Accordingly, Plaintiffs' motion (Dkt. No. 220) is DENIED without prejudice. Plaintiffs may again move for certification once the Court lifts the stay. Defendants' motion for relief from the deadline to respond to Plaintiffs' motion (Dkt. No. 222) is DENIED as moot.
