

ORDER DISMISSING
COUNTERCLAIMS WITHOUT
PREJUDICE

15 On January 23, 2018, the court issued an order granting Defendant WOW 1 Day
16 Painting, LLC's ("WOW") motion for summary judgment and directing the parties to
17 show cause why WOW's compulsory counterclaims should not be dismissed without
18 prejudice. (Order (Dkt. # 42).) On January 31, 2018, the parties responded to the court's
19 order to show cause. (WOW Resp. (Dkt. # 45); DiNardo Resp. (Dkt. # 43).) Both WOW
20 and Plaintiff Val DiNardo agree that WOW's counterclaims should be dismissed without
21 prejudice. (*See* WOW Resp. at 2 ("WOW respectfully submits that considerations of
22 judicial economy, convenience, and fairness to the litigants are served by dismissing the

1 counterclaims without prejudice”); DiNardo Resp. at 5 (“[T]his Court should
2 dismiss the remaining Counterclaims without prejudice.”.) Accordingly, the court
3 DISMISSES WOW’s counterclaims WITHOUT PREJUDICE.¹ The court further
4 DIRECTS the Clerk to close this file.
