See LCR 7(b)(2). 24 Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Defendant's Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. #4) is 25 **GRANTED** and Plaintiff's Complaint is dismissed with prejudice. The Clerk of the Court is 26 directed to enter judgment in favor of Defendant.
