17 This matter came before the Court on the United States' Motion to Dismiss. Dkt. #4.
18 The Court has reviewed the motion, all evidence submitted in support of the motion, as well
19 as the documents on file, and is otherwise fully informed. The United States has not waived
20 sovereign immunity for claims outside of an employee's scope of employment and Plaintiff's
21 Complaint fails to state a claim for theft or conversion. Plaintiff has failed to file a Response
22 to this Motion, and this failure is construed by the Court as an admission that this Motion has
23 merit. *See* LCR 7(b)(2).

24 Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Defendant's Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. #4) is
25 **GRANTED** and Plaintiff's Complaint is dismissed with prejudice. The Clerk of the Court is
26 directed to enter judgment in favor of Defendant.
