19	Judge, Dkt. 6. Presently before the Court is Defendant's Stipulated Motion for Remand	
20	("Motion"). Dkt. 18. After reviewing the Motion and the relevant record, the Court orders the	
21	following:	
22	Defendant's Motion is granted, and the case is reversed and remanded for further	
23	administrative proceedings under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).	
24	On remand, the Commissioner shall:	

1	Reassess the opinions of treating psychiatrist, Richard Ries, M.D.; examining	
2	psychologists Barbara Lui, Ph.D., and R.A. Cline, Psy.D.; and other sources, case	
3	manager Natalie Frick, and mental health counselor, Caitlin Cotter;	
4	Reassess Plaintiff's residual functional capacity in light of the preceding assessments,	
5	as well as other steps in the sequential evaluation process, as necessary;	
6	The ALJ will offer Plaintiff an opportunity for a hearing; and	
7	Plaintiff may also present new arguments and further medical evidence, if such	
8	evidence becomes available.	
9	The parties agree that on proper motion the Court should consider Plaintiff's application	
10	for attorney fees and costs under 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d).
