ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME AND DENYING
MISCELLANEOUS MOTIONS

14 This is a prisoner civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Currently before the Court
15 are plaintiff's "Motion for Notification of Rights Violations by Def. Morgan and Assoc." (Dkt. 40
16 at 1), "Motion of extension for Amended Complaint due date" (Dkt. 40 at 2-3), "Motion of request
17 for transfer out Washington State Dept. of Corrections" (Dkt. 41), an updated and modified
18 "Motion of extension of Time for filing of amended complaint" (Dkt. 42 at 1-3), and a second
19 "Motion of Notification of Rights violations by Def. Morgan and assoc. and an order compelling
20 compliance" (Dkt. 42 at 4-7). Having reviewed the motions, the Court ORDERS:

21 (1) Plaintiff's motions for extension of time to file an amended complaint (Dkt. 40 at
22 2-3; Dkt. 42 at 1-3) are GRANTED. Given that plaintiff's access to legal materials seems

1 intermittent, the Court will grant a 60-day extension, instead of the 30-day extension plaintiff
2 requested. Plaintiff shall file his amended complaint on or before **May 30, 2017**.

3 (2) In the remaining motions, plaintiff asks the Court to stop alleged rights violations
4 by Defendant Morgan and his associates and to order that he be transferred out of Washington
5 State. The motions (Dkt. 40 at 1; Dkt. 41; Dkt. 42 at 4-7) are STRICKEN as premature. Plaintiff
6 has not presented the Court with a viable complaint. Until a complaint is filed that survives the
7 mandatory screening process, the Court will strike any motions by plaintiff except for ones
8 requesting additional time to file an amended complaint.

9 (3) The Clerk shall direct copies of this Order to plaintiff and to the Honorable Robert
10 S. Lasnik.
