This matter comes before the Court on the parties' stipulated motion to extend the briefing schedule on Plaintiff Northwest Environmental Advocates' motion for attorney fees (Dkt. No. 191). Plaintiff and the Federal Defendants<sup>1</sup> request that the Court extend Federal Defendants' deadline to respond to Plaintiff's motion until May 6, 2021 and Plaintiff's reply deadline until May 20, 2021 because the parties have reached a tentative settlement and Federal Defendants must seek approval from appropriate officials. 4	Plaintiff's motion for attorney fees (Dkt. No. 177) for consideration on May 20, 2021.
5	Defendants must file any responses to Plaintiff's motion no later than May 6, 2021.
