
ORDER

14 By Minute Order dated July 29, 2019, docket no. 39, the Court directed plaintiff to
15 show cause why this action should not be dismissed for failing to comply with the Minute

17 received no response to the “show cause” Minute Order, and no Joint Status Report

19 R. Civ. P. 41(b); *see also Wallace v. Hinton*, 2000 WL 1728285 (9th Cir. Nov. 20, 2000)
20 (affirming dismissal without prejudice for failure to timely file a joint status report (citing
21 *Malone v. U.S. Postal Serv.*, 833 F.2d 128, 132 (9th Cir. 1987))).
