16 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable John C.  
17 Coughenour, United States District Judge:

18 This matter comes before the Court on Defendants' motion for extension of time to  
19 respond to Plaintiffs' motion for class certification (Dkt. No. 26) from February 27, 2017 to  
20 April 10, 2017 (Dkt. No. 35). Plaintiffs' filed an amended complaint on February 1, 2017, adding  
21 challenges to the President's Executive Order (No. 13,769, 82 Fed. Reg. 8977) of January 27,  
22 2017, entitled "Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States." (Dkt.  
23 No. 17.) On February 7, Plaintiffs notified the Court that the acting director of the U.S.  
24 Citizenship and Immigration Services ("USCIS") issued a memo stating "Section 3(c) of the  
25 Executive Order does not affect USCIS adjudication of applications and petitions filed for or on  
26 behalf of individuals in the United States regardless of their country of nationality." (Dkt. No. 22
