ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S
MOTION TO DISMISS

15 This matter came before the Court on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss. Dkt. #7. The Court
16 has reviewed the Motion, all evidence submitted in support of the motion, and Defendant's reply, as
17 well as the documents on file, and is otherwise fully informed. Plaintiff has failed to file a Response
18 or otherwise communicate with the Court in this matter. The failure to file a response "may be
19 considered by the court as an admission that the motion has merit." Local Civil Rule 7(b)(2). The
20 Court finds that Plaintiff's Complaint fails for lack of subject matter jurisdiction and fails to state a
21 claim upon which relief can be granted, and that dismissal with prejudice is warranted given
22 Plaintiff's lack of response to the instant Motion and for the other reasons stated by Defendant in its
23 Motion. *See* Dkt. #7 at 7.
