15 16	Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746(2), I. Mohammad Shafiei Khadem, hereby declare as follows:	
17	1. I am over the age of eighteen and competent to testify herein.	
18	2. I live in Seattle, Washington.	
19 20	3. I'm an Iranian-American dual citizen.	
21	4. I am a Senior Software Engineer at Microsoft. Microsoft is a software/technology	
22	company that contributes greatly to Seattle's, Washington's, and USA's economy. The	
23	most important asset of the company is its top talent. I am a top talent. In 2013, I received	
24	an Engineering Excellence Award, which is one of the highest achievements for	
25	Microsoft engineering employees worldwide. The award recognizes excellence in

driving efficiency and results, optimizing business through cost or process savings, leveraging existing technologies or processes across divisional boundaries, and designing innovative and novel solutions to address engineering challenges. My work is valued at Microsoft and is important.

- 5. However, I am greatly impacted by the newest travel ban. Due to the recent proclamation issued on 9/24/17, my parents and brother will not be able to get a visa to visit me anymore after 10/18/17. While due to compulsory 2-year military service required by the Iranian government for all male Iranian citizens, I cannot travel to Iran freely either because I do not agree with serving in the Iranian military. This puts a great burden on myself and my family and breaks my heart since we cannot visit each other in person anymore. I might be getting married in the next few years and it is very important for me to have my family with me. In addition, for the longer term, I am hoping to bring them as immigrants to live closer to me so that I can take care of them as they get older.
- 6. If the newest travel ban goes forward, then I must consider moving somewhere that my family can visit or live with me if they choose to. I have studied in Canada and I am seriously considering moving to Canada as an alternative option. Moving to Europe is another alternative that I am considering.
