## SECOND DECLARATION OF RITA ZAWAIDEH

- in business for 30 years. Since 2003, Caravan-Serai has been rated by Conde Nast Traveler magazine as a Top Travel Specialist.
- 3. I am also the founder of Salaam Cultural Museum (SCM). SCM is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that focuses on the specific task of bringing relief and aid to people affected by conflict and natural disaster within the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region, and to bring people and cultures together to build bridges of understanding. SCM organizes medical and humanitarian missions to Greece and Jordan to assist Syrian refugees fleeing from the civil war in their country. I founded SCM in 1990.
- 4. Since President Trump issued his first Executive Order on January 27, 2017, Caravan-Serai's business has almost completely evaporated. Since submitting my initial declaration in March, 2017, I have organized one (1) group tour for about 5 individuals. Last year, in the same period of time, from March to October, I had about five (5) to ten (10) group tours *per month* for from seven (7) to fifteen (15) people each.
- 5. During this same, from March 2017 to the present, I have organized a total of about ten (10) Foreign Independent Travel tours for 1 or 2 individuals each. Last year, for the same period of time, I organized around ten (10) to twenty (20) of these tours *per month*. My customers have told me that they are simply afraid to travel because they are concerned about whether they will be able to reenter the United States when they return from their trip. Even U.S. citizens have told me that they are afraid to go.
- 6. I have also had to cancel all planned SCM medical humanitarian missions. These are missions that I organize to send physicians and other health care professionals to Greece and Jordan to provide medical care to Syrian refugees. The physicians and other professionals who would go, many of whom are natives of the Middle East and North Africa but are U.S. citizens, have also told me that they are afraid to go on the mission for fear of not being able to reenter the U.S. or being subjected to severe harassment and scrutiny by U.S. Customs and Border Protection upon their return.

- 7. I normally would organize a medical humanitarian mission every 45 days, and they would consist of 15 to 20 physicians and other health care professionals. I had one mission organized for next month, November, 2017, but it is likely now that I will have to cancel that mission as well because of the participants' fears as noted above.
- 8. The President's Executive Order of January 27, 2017, as well as the second one that became effective March 16, 2017, has caused my business to lose almost all of its revenue. My revenue is down by approximately eighty percent (80%). I have had to reduce my employees' hours by half. However, even with that reduction, I cannot continue to employ them indefinitely if I have no income from which to pay them.
