**STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED]
ORDER TO EXTEND DEADLINE
FOR SUBMITTING JOINT STATUS
REPORT**

Pursuant to the May 30, 2017, Stipulation and Order to Stay Proceedings, Dkt. # 34, Plaintiffs and Defendants, through their respective undersigned counsel, hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Plaintiffs challenge Executive Order 13,780, titled "Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States." See 82 Fed. Reg. 13,209 (Mar. 6, 2017). Plaintiffs have filed a Second Amended Class Action Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief contesting the legality of the Executive Order, Dkt. # 30, as well as a Motion for Class Certification, Dkt. # 19.

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1 2. On May 17, 2017, and May 22, 2017, respectively, the Court entered orders
2 staying the proceedings in *Washington v. Trump*, No. 17-141JLR (W.D. Wash.), Dkt. # 189, and
3 *Ali v. Trump*, No. 17-135JLR (W.D. Wash.), Dkt. # 95, pending resolution of the appeal in
4 *Hawaii v. Trump*, No. 17-15589 (9th Cir.).

5 3. In light of the Court's orders staying proceedings in *Washington* and *Ali*,
6 Plaintiffs and Defendants stipulated to a similar stay in this case. Pursuant to the parties'
7 stipulation, on May 30, 2017, the Court entered an Order staying all proceedings in this case
8 pending the Ninth Circuit's resolution of the appeal in *Hawaii*. See Stipulation and Order to
9 Stay Proceedings, Dkt. # 34. The Court further ordered the parties to file a joint status report
10 within ten days of the Ninth Circuit's ruling in *Hawaii* so that the Court could evaluate the
11 continued appropriateness of a stay at that time.

12 4. On June 12, 2017, the Ninth Circuit issued its decision in *Hawaii*, affirming in
13 part and vacating in part the district court's entry of a preliminary injunction against enforcement
14 of Sections 2 and 6 of the Executive Order. See *Hawaii v. Trump*, No. 17-15589, 2017 WL
15 2529640 (9th Cir. June 12, 2017). The Ninth Circuit overturned certain portions of the injunction
16 involving internal-review procedures, but it upheld the remainder based on statutory grounds.
17 Accordingly, the parties' joint status report is currently due on June 22, 2017.

18 5. On May 25, 2017, the Fourth Circuit issued a decision in *International Refugee*
19 *Assistance Project v. Trump*, 857 F.3d 554 (4th Cir. 2017) (en banc), affirming a preliminary
20 injunction against enforcement of Section 2(c) of the Executive Order on Establishment Clause
21 grounds.

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1 6. Defendants have sought Supreme Court review of the courts of appeals decisions
2 in both *Hawaii* and *IRAP*. In particular, Defendants have asked the Supreme Court to grant
3 certiorari in both cases so that they may be considered together and to stay the preliminary
4 injunctions in both cases pending disposition of the petitions for writ of certiorari and any further
5 proceedings in the Supreme Court. *See Hawaii*, No. 16A-1191 (filed June 1, 2017); *IRAP*, No.
6 16-1436 (filed June 1, 2017); *IRAP*, No. 16A-1190 (filed June 1, 2017). Defendants also
7 requested expedited briefing on and consideration of their petitions for writ of certiorari so that
8 the petitions could be considered before the Supreme Court adjourns for the summer and, if the
9 Supreme Court grants review, merits briefing could be completed by the beginning of next Term.
10 Pursuant to the schedules set by the Supreme Court, the certiorari petitions and stay applications
11 were fully briefed on June 21, 2017.

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14 7. To permit the parties to benefit from any decision(s) by the Supreme Court on the
15 certiorari petitions and stay applications in *Hawaii* and *IRAP* before filing a joint status report
16 on the continued appropriateness of the stay in this case, the parties stipulate and agree to an
17 extension of time for submission of their joint status report. The parties shall file a joint status
18 report on the continued appropriateness of the stay by July 14, 2017.

19 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between Plaintiffs
20 and Defendants, subject to the Court's approval, that:

22 A. The parties shall file a joint status report on the continued appropriateness of the
23 stay in this case by July 14, 2017.

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
