16                   MINUTE ORDER

17                   The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable  
18                   Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

19                   (1) Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to File Third Amended Complaint, docket  
20                   no. 51, is GRANTED. Plaintiffs shall electronically file the Third Amended Complaint  
21                   via the Case Management and Electronic Case Filing ("CM/ECF") system within seven  
22                   (7) days of the date of this Minute Order. Using the CM/ECF system, plaintiffs shall add  
23                   any new parties and terminate any parties no longer named in the Amended Complaint,  
24                   as applicable. Any answer or other response is due within fourteen (14) days after the  
25                   Third Amended Complaint is filed. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(a)(3).

26                   (2) Defendant's Motion to Dismiss, docket no. 49, is STRICKEN as moot.

27                   (3) All discovery in this action is STAYED pending further order of the Court.  
28                   Defendant's Motion to Stay Discovery, docket no. 57, is STRICKEN as moot.

(4) The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Minute Order to all counsel of record.
