

ORDER DISMISSING  
COMPLAINT WITHOUT  
PREJUDICE

16 On March 6, 2017, the court entered an order dismissing Plaintiff Ike Njoku's  
17 complaint without prejudice for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. (Order (Dkt. # 4).)  
18 Nevertheless, the court granted Mr. Njoku 21 days following the entry of that order to file  
19 an amended complaint that corrected the deficiencies noted in the court's order and  
20 properly alleged some basis for federal court subject matter jurisdiction. (*Id.* at 4-5.) The  
21 court warned Mr. Njoku that failure to timely comply with the court's order would result  
22 in the dismissal of his complaint "without prejudice and without further notice to him."

1 (*Id.* at 5.) More than 21 days have passed since the court filed its order, and Mr. Njoku  
2 has failed to file an amended complaint or any other response to the court's order. (*See*  
3 *generally* Dkt.) Accordingly, the court DISMISSES his complaint WITHOUT  
4 PREJUDICE.
