MINUTE ORDER

12 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable
Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

13 (1) Plaintiff's motion for default judgment, docket no. 10, is DENIED without
14 prejudice. Plaintiff initiated this action against defendants Vitamilk Dairy, Inc.
15 ("Vitamilk") and Does 1-25, which are alleged to be business entities that "share
16 common ownership and are in the same controlled group as Vitamilk." Compl. at ¶ 4
(docket no. 1). Plaintiff, however, moves for default judgment only as to Vitamilk,
without providing a basis for the Court to make the certification required by Federal Rule
of Civil Procedure 54(b) to enter partial judgment.

17 (2) The Clerk is DIRECTED to send a copy of this Minute Order to all counsel
18 of record. The Clerk is further DIRECTED to send a copy of this Minute Order, as well
19 as a copy of the Minute Order entering default, docket no. 9, to Vitamilk Dairy, Inc., c/o
