MINUTE ORDER

11 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable
12 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

13 (1) Plaintiff's motion for reconsideration, docket no. 15, is DENIED. Plaintiff
14 previously moved for partial default judgment as to defendant Vitamilk Dairy, Inc.
15 without providing a basis for the Court to make the certification required by Federal Rule
16 of Civil Procedure 54(b); the motion was therefore denied without prejudice. *See* Minute
Order (docket no. 13). Plaintiff has since voluntarily dismissed its claims against
17 defendants Does 1-25, but it has not shown that the Court's earlier ruling was manifestly
erroneous or identified any new facts or legal authority that could not have been brought
18 to the Court's attention earlier with reasonable diligence. *See* Local Civil Rule 7(h)(1).
