ORDER GRANTING NORTHWEST
TRUSTEE SERVICES, INC.'S
MOTION TO DISMISS

This matter comes before the Court on defendant Northwest Trustee Services, Inc.'s motion to dismiss under Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6). Dkt. # 7.
