Zilly, United States District Judge: 14 (1) On May 1, 2017, the United States International Trade Commission initiated an investigation of several respondents, including defendant Majestic Mirrors & 15 Frame, LLC, under Section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, at plaintiffs' request. See Defendant's Consented Motion, Ex. 1, docket no. 17-2 at 3. Pursuant to 28 16 U.S.C. § 1659, a district court presiding over a civil action involving parties also involved in a proceeding before the United States International Trade Commission (the 17 "Commission") under section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, upon the timely request of a party who is also a respondent in the proceeding before the Commission, shall stay the 18 action with respect to any claim that involves the same issues as the proceeding before the Commission, until the determination of the Commission becomes final. See 28 19 U.S.C. § 1659(a). A stay under § 1659 "requires that the stay of district court proceedings continue until the Commission proceedings are no longer subject to judicial 20 review." In re Princo Corp., 478 F.3d 1345, 1355 (Fed. Cir. 2007). The infringement claims at issue in this action involve the same patents—U.S. Patent Nos. 7,853,414 and 21 7,559,668, see Proposed Amended Complaint, docket no. 15—and appear to involve the same issues that are now before the Commission. Defendant, who is a respondent in the 22 23

1	matter is hereby STAYED until the determination of the Commission becomes final. The parties are DIRECTED to file a Joint Status Report within twenty-one (21) days after the determination of the Commission becomes final or by January 24, 2018, whichever
