Plaintiff requests relief from the Rule 26(f) Conference 16 deadline, which passed on June 5, 2017, and that the Court set a new deadline of June 23, 2017. *Id*. 17 Plaintiff also appears to request relief from the initial disclosures and Joint Status Report deadlines. 18 Id. Plaintiff argues that this relief is necessary to allow her to continue to contact and confer with 19 all Defendants, none of which have made an appearance in this matter. Id. Plaintiff also states that 20 she will be receiving a report from Certified Forensic Loan Auditors on June 20, 2017, which will 21 contain necessary information for her to proceed with these activities. *Id*. 22 23 24

The 3 Court will likewise extend the initial disclosure deadline to June 30, 2017, and the Joint Status 4 Report deadline to July 7, 2017. 5 Having reviewed the relevant briefing, and the remainder of the record, the Court hereby 6 finds and ORDERS that Plaintiff Annette Blanchard's Motion for "Temporary Extension of Time" 7 (Dkt. #9) is GRANTED.
