4 must include them in his responsive brief within the applicable page limits. See LCR 7(e).
5 Should he choose to do so, Plaintiff may re-file an amended Response no later than July 20,
6 2018. Thereafter, Defendants shall have until July 25, 2018 to file their Reply.
