1 Good cause exists for this extension. The parties are attempting to resolve this matter
2 without further involvement from the Court, thereby saving the parties' and the Court's
3 resources. The parties are attempting to agree on the appropriate accommodation to provide to
4 plaintiff in light of his circumstances. The parties need additional time to resolve that issue.
5 The parties are also working cooperatively to attempt to resolve the amount of attorney's fees
6 plaintiff is due. The parties seek to avoid the expenditure of additional time and government
7 resources that would result if the parties must write and file their objections while simultaneously
8 trying to resolve those matters.

12 the Report and Recommendation.
