1 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable
2 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

3 (1) Trustee's Motion for Stay or in the Alternative Motion for Protective Order,
4 docket no. 68, is DENIED.

5 (2) Pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 502(d), the Court ORDERS that the
6 Trustee will not waive the attorney-client privilege simply by producing e-mail
7 documents to LVB-Ogden Marketing Corporation ("LVB") in response to the Court's
8 December 28, 2017, and February 8, 2018, Minute Orders, docket nos. 53 and 67,
9 respectively.

10 (3) In light of Paragraph 2, the Trustee can immediately produce to LVB all
11 emails he has collected and has yet to review for privilege. *See* docket no. 55 at 4. LVB
12 may then review these documents and identify responsive documents to the Trustee as
13 they are reviewed.

14 (4) As set forth in this Court's February 8, 2018, Minute Order, docket no. 67,
15 the Trustee's deadline to comply with the Court's orders compelling production of
16 documents was March 30, 2018. No further extensions shall be granted.

17 (5) The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Minute Order to all counsel of
18 record.
