

ORDER DISMISSING ACTION
WITHOUT PREJUDICE

15 On September 21, 2017, the court ordered Plaintiff Sanaa Hammou to show cause
16 why this action should not be dismissed for failure to serve Defendant with a summons
17 and copy of the complaint within the timeframe provided in Federal Rule of Civil
18 Procedure 4(m). (OSC (Dkt. # 12).) The court ordered Plaintiff to respond within ten
19 days and warned Plaintiff that a failure to demonstrate good cause for the failure to
20 comply with Rule 4(m) would result in dismissal of the action without prejudice. (*Id.* at
21 2.) More than ten days have passed since the court issued its order, and Plaintiff has
22 failed to respond. (*See generally* Dkt.) Accordingly, the court DISMISSES Plaintiff's

1 complaint without prejudice for failure to demonstrate good cause for Plaintiff's failure to
2 comply with Rule 4(m).
