MINUTE ORDER

12 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable  
13 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

14 (1) Pursuant to the stipulation between plaintiff United States of America and  
15 defendant Shaun Allahyari, docket no. 39, Diane E. Tebelius and Sandra Veliz of  
LeSourd & Patten, P.S. are GRANTED leave to withdraw as counsel of record for Shaun  
Allahyari, effective immediately, and John S. Kaplan of Perkins Coie LLP is substituted  
as counsel of record for Shaun Allahyari.

16 (2) Defendant Komron M. Allahyari's unopposed motion, docket no. 40, to

Substitution (docket no. 23).
