The parties, however, fail to comply with Local Rule LCR 26(c)(2). See Local Rules W.D. Wash. LCR 26(c)(2). Pursuant to this rule, "[p]arties are encouraged 17 18 to use this district's model protective order, available on the court's website," but those 19 "[p]arties that wish to depart from the model order must provide the court with a redlined 20 version identifying departures from the model." *Id.* Here, the parties appear to use the

model protective order as a basis for their filing, but they fail to provide the court a

redlined version as required under the local rules. Accordingly, the court DENIES the
