MINUTE ORDER GRANTING WAIVER

15 The following MINUTE ORDER is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable
16 Ricardo S. Martinez, Chief United States District Judge:

17 On March 20, 2018, attorney David W. Smith, filed an application for leave to appear *pro*
18 *hac vice* on behalf of non-party Estes Express Lines. Dkt. #83. Mr. Smith seeks to appear for
19 this non-party for the limited purpose of moving to quash a subpoena. *Id.* Accordingly, Mr.
20 Smith seeks a waiver of the local counsel requirement as it would be expensive and inefficient
21 to hire multiple counsel for that limited purpose. *Id.* The Court agrees with Mr. Smith for the
22 reasons he sets forth. Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Mr. Smith's request for a waiver of the
23 local counsel requirement and will allow him to appear *pro hac vice* without associating local
24 counsel.
