ORDER

The Court has reviewed Plaintiff's motion for reconsideration. Dkt. # 39. Pursuant to Local Rules W.D. Wash. CR 7(h)(1), motions for reconsideration are disfavored, and will ordinarily be denied unless there is a showing of (a) manifest error in the prior ruling, or (b) facts or legal authority which could not have been brought to the

1 attention of the court earlier, through reasonable diligence. Plaintiff brings his second
2 motion for reconsideration “to make sure the Ninth Circuit is aware of precisely what the
3 Court did here.” Dkt. # 39 at 1. Plaintiff reiterates his arguments from his prior motion
4 for reconsideration but offers nothing new in support of his contention that the Court
5 erred in its decision. Plaintiff’s motion for reconsideration is therefore **DENIED**.
