




1 Gomes initially filed and the court addressed in its order to show cause. (*Compare id.* at  
2 2-4, 10, *with* Compl. (Dkt. # 4) at 1-3, *and* EEOC Charge (Dkt. # 4-1) at 1.)

3 The court's order to show cause cautioned Mr. Gomes that failure to timely  
4 respond to the court's order or remedy the deficiencies identified in the order would  
5 result in the dismissal of his complaint. (6/19/17 Order at 4.) Mr. Gomes failed to  
6 respond to the order to show cause (*see* Dkt.), and his only filing subsequent to the  
7 court's order to show cause fails to cure the deficiencies that the court identified (*see*  
8 6/19/17 Order at 1-4; Pr. at 1-10). Accordingly, the court concludes that Mr. Gomes's  
9 untimely EEOC charge forecloses his claim and DISMISSES his complaint with  
10 prejudice and without leave to amend.
