MINUTE ORDER

14 The following MINUTE ORDER is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable  
15 Ricardo S. Martinez, Chief United States District Judge:

16 On August 31, 2018, Plaintiff filed a Stipulated Motion and Order for Dismissal of Pacific  
17 Maritime Association as a Party to the Action. Dkt. #84.<sup>1</sup> However, the “stipulated motion” is  
18 not signed by Defendant Faron Fletcher. The Court therefore DENIES the Stipulated Motion.

20 The parties may either (1) file a stipulated dismissal signed by all parties, (2) a stipulated  
21 motion signed by all parties, or (3) a party may move for an order of dismissal, noting the motion  
22 in accordance with Local Civil Rule 7(d)(3).
