ORDER REVERSING AND REMANDING
FOR FURTHER ADMINISTRATIVE
PROCEEDINGS

15 Plaintiff brought this action to seek judicial review of the denial of his application for
16 disability benefits by the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration. Dkt. 4. The
17 parties have stipulated that this case should be reversed and remanded for further administrative
18 proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). Dkt. 14.

19 Based on the stipulation of the parties, the Court ORDERS that this case be REVERSED
20 and REMANDED for further administrative proceedings before an Administrative Law Judge
21 (“ALJ”), including a *de novo* hearing. On remand, the ALJ shall: reevaluate the opinions of Drs.
22 Sawyer, Morey, and Burdge; reevaluate plaintiff’s subjective testimony and, as necessary, his

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1 residual functional capacity; and continue on with the sequential evaluation process, obtaining
2 supplemental vocational expert testimony as necessary.
